information on the reverse side of this page.







THE GREAT RACE - This GREAT race is actually a rallye sponsored by Interstate Battery Co. It is a reinactment of a rallye from years past and will cover 3660 miles and 10 states. For the first time, the rallye will have a Southern route beginning at Disneyland, California on June 30, 1987 and ending at Disney World in Florida.

This year the 1934 Ford in which outlaws Bonnie & Clyde were killed will enter the race. The car still has the 167 bullet holes visable. There is also a 1909 Stanley Steamer entered that will require its own water truck in the vicinity during the competition.

Some of you may have seen the race televised. The "stop" towns along the way plan for months in advance for the festivities surrounding this event. The event is always free of charge and the cars are available for close inspection and the driver/navigator teams available for chats and pictures with the public. 100,000 Great Race stickers will be given out along the route.
