### **Dent Doctor and Roadshow Mini at September's Meeting**

Dent Doctor Vince Hood gave an interesting presentation and demonstration at the September meeting. Vince showed off some of the special tools he uses to massage sheet metal dents back to their original contours. He kept most of his secrets to himself, but did offer BSCC members a discount if they came to his shop. Vince did reveal one secret: he puts a strip of black tape down the length of his shop's fluorescent light tubes to help see any remaining ripples in the sheet metal. The tape casts a straight or curved shadow over smooth surfaces; the ripples show up as wavy lines. Take your car for a dent massage to Vince at 2693 Mt. 
#### **BSCC Car Fest October 4&5!**


