Lincoln Collector Presents Slide Show on Body Types

Dennis Keifer, past vice president of the Lincoln Owners Club, presented his fascinating slide show on automobile body types at the January BSCC meeting. The slide show is the result of meticulous research by Dennis on the origins of coachwork terms, beginning with a biblical reference to Solomon's chariot (special ordered and made of silver and gold; the first custom coachwork on record), and tracing the development of body types to the present time. Some of his research involved checking definitions of coach terms in nineteenth century dictionaries printed well before the automobile was developed. The slide show contains illustrations of both horse-drawn and automotive variants of roadsters, phaetons, convertibles, coupes, landaus, landaulettes, berlines, and many others. Dennis' humorous but matter-of-fact delivery kept the audience's full attention during the presentation, and the club extends its most gracious thanks to Dennis and his wife Patsy for taking the time to visit us.



Our thanks to Mr. and Mrs. Keifer for the fine presentation and to Walt Fisher for making the arrangements.




